

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE: DOGWOOD TRAINING CENTER

From the north via I-45 south or Hwy 59 south: Exit Beltway 8 West (North Sam Houston Pkwy from 59, North Sam Houston Tollway from I-45), travel west (6.5 miles west of I-45) to the Fairbanks-N. Houston Rd Exit., stay on the access road to the second light which will be Fairbanks-N. Houston Rd., turn left (south), travel approximately 1.75 miles to traffic light at West Rd., turn left (east), travel ½ block. Dogwood will be on your right.

From the west via I-10 east or Hwy. 59 north: Exit Beltway 8 north (Sam Houston Tollway), travel north (11.5 miles north of I-10) past Hwy. 290 and the horse race track to exit at Fairbanks-N. Houston Rd., turn right (south), travel approximately 1.75 miles to traffic light at West Rd., turn left (east), travel ½ block. Dogwood will be on your right.

From the south via I-45 north or from the east via I-10 west: pass downtown proceeding on (or exiting to) I-10 west to Loop 610, exit West Loop North; after 1.25 miles exit Hwy. 290 (left lane exit) to Austin, travel 5.5 miles northwest to exit at Fairbanks-N. Houston, turn right (north), travel 3 miles to traffic light at West Rd., turn right (east), travel ½ block. Dogwood will be on your right.

Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted after entries have closed at 6 p.m., Wednesday, January 12, 2011 as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows." Entries received without fees or signature cannot be accepted. Telephone, telegraph, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED IN THE EVENT THAT A DOG IS ABSENT, DISQUALIFIED, EXCUSED BY THE VETERINARIAN OR JUDGE, OR BARRED FROM COMPETITION BY THE SHOW COMMITTEE. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

Move-ups in Rally and Obedience will be allowed as specified in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

ATTENTION OBEDIENCE AND RALLY EXHIBITORS: THE AKC RULES REGARDING PRACTICING OF DOGS ON SHOW GROUNDS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

BRED-BY EXHIBITOR (BBE) CLASS ELIGIBILITY

- •All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC.
- •The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- •To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under AKC Rules will be allowed within the show grounds. No puppies under six (6) months of age will be allowed on the show grounds.

AS SPACE IS LIMITED, **NO EXERCISE PENS WILL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE BUILDING**. There is ample room outside the building for exercise pens. We prefer **NO BLOW DRYERS INSIDE THE BUILDING**. IF THEY BECOME A PROBLEM YOU WILL HAVE TO TAKE THEM OUTSIDE. <u>NO CHALKING ON SHOW GROUNDS</u>.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Judges will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged.

Show and Committee Chairs may exhibit at this show.

The show-giving club does not assume any responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES. THE SHOW-GIVING CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY DOGS FOUND IN DISTRESS IN A VEHICLE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS AND ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW HEREBY WAIVE ANY CLAIM FOR DAMAGES AGAINST THE CLUB FOR SUCH REMOVAL.

The show-giving club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

There will be no overnight parking of RVs or other vehicles in the Dogwood parking lots. Please park oversized vehicles on the days of the shows in the back parking lot.

Exhibitors are expected to honor any and all rules in effect at the Dogwood Training Facility. The Agility areas are off limits to all exhibitors – NO EXCEPTIONS! Anyone not honoring this rule will be asked to leave.

Show hours will be from 11:00 am to 10:00 p.m. on Friday, January 28, 2011. The Building will be available from 11:00 am to 10:00 pm on Friday, January 28, 2011.

Crates and grooming equipment may be left in the locked building Friday and Saturday nights, but exhibitors do so at their own risk. Security will NOT be provided. The Shetland Sheepdog Club of Houston, the Shoreline Shetland Sheepdog Club of Baytown, and the Dogwood Training Center assume no responsibility for anything lost or stolen. No dogs may be left in the building overnight.

ALL EQUIPMENT MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE BUILDING IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE JUDGING OF BEST OF BREED ON SUNDAY.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. The State of Texas is under a rabies alert. Proof of a rabies vaccination may be required. Tags are not sufficient for proof of vaccinations.

<u>NOTICE</u>: The show-giving club reserves the right to cancel the events if extreme weather conditions threaten the well-being of dogs and participants, per the American Kennel Club guidelines issued July 28, 1995.

The Shoreline Shetland Sheepdog Club of Baytown does <u>not</u> agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.

Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008, The AKC will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events.
